

General information

Postgraduate students successfully completing a semester of study aboard The Scholar Ship may, subject to approval by the Institute of Liberal Arts of the Universidad de Navarra, apply their course credits towards a Master of Arts in Liberal Arts. Completion of the Master of Arts will require **two additional semesters in Pamplona, Spain at Universidad de Navarra**. In addition, after completing the required courses, students will have to complete a thesis under the direction of a supervisor.

Admissions requirements

Graduates with a bachelor's degree (or the equivalent) from recognized colleges and universities may apply for admission. Although many courses are taught in English, the majority of courses are taught in Spanish and nonnative speakers of Spanish must demonstrate they have a high level of Spanish by passing either the Cervantes Institute Exam or an exam given the Institute for Spanish Language and Culture (ILCE) at the Universidad de Navarra. ILCE also organizes intensive Spanish language courses in the summer for students who need to improve their Spanish before enrollment. For more information: <http://www.unav.es/ilce/default.html>.

Start Dates

Students can choose to start their studies at the Universidad de Navarra either September or mid-February. Deadlines for applications are 30 April for the September semester, and 30 October for the February intake.
