

General information

Postgraduate students successfully completing a semester of study aboard The Scholar Ship may, subject to approval by EGADE, apply their course credits towards a Master of International Business (MIB). This is a pre-experience degree that requires two additional trimesters (approximately 6 months) in Monterrey, NL, Mexico at EGADE and a three month work placement (which can be completed anywhere in the world).

Admissions requirements

Graduates with a bachelor's degree (or the equivalent) from recognized colleges and universities may apply for admission. Candidates must take either the postgraduate admissions test administered by Tecnológico de Monterrey or submit official results of the GMAT exam for consideration – a minimum score of 550 on either of these exams is required for admission. Students must also complete a personal interview, which may be conducted by telephone. Students for whom English is not their native language or who have not completed an undergraduate degree at an English medium institution must have present evidence of a minimum official TOEFL score of 550 for full-time enrollment in the program.

All candidates undergo a selection process based on the information provided in their applications. Pre-selected applicants will be interviewed.
