Postgraduate students may, subject to approval by Macquarie University, earn a Postgraduate Certificate in International Communication entirely onboard The Scholar Ship in one semester. An examination fee of AUD\$800 is required in addition to fees paid to The Scholar Ship.

Admissions requirements

You must have earned (or anticipate earning) a minimum of a bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from a recognized institution prior to the voyage with a 2.5 GPA (Australian). Evidence of English language proficiency is also required if English is not your first language. Please see our [Application Instructions](#) for minimum requirements.

Your complete academic record will be assessed to determine suitability for admission and you should be prepared to succeed in a rigorous academic environment. You will receive joint notification from The Scholar Ship and Macquarie University regarding your admission.

The following subject is also required for this certificate:

- TICM821 Intercultural Communication (MQ ICOM821)

You must also select one other subject in the International Communication Learning Circle to be credited towards the Postgraduate Certificate in International Communication. The following subjects meet this requirement:

- TICM815 Communication and Power Paradigms in International Relations
- TICM892 International Public Relations and Advertising

Please note that TICA801 International Communication is not applicable towards this Certificate.
